1. Apologies

Apologies were received as above and everyone was welcomed to the meeting.

2. Matters Arising

There were no matters arising.

3. Working Groups

3.1 Working group meeting detailed notes are all held in the central Dropbox folder. The progress of each group so far was summarised by a spokesperson.

3.2 **Environment – John Midgley**

- JM updated the group on progress on protecting proposed areas of Crich railway from further development.
- KO provided maps with significant areas marked for the group to use.

3.3 **Business – Chris Collison**

- CC reported that various topics are being worked on within the group, including policies to support:
 - i) working from home
 - ii) land already in commercial use
 - iii) development of brownfield land already in commercial use
 - iv) proposed conversion of buildings within the market place to commercial use
 - v) proposed change of use of agricultural buildings for small business use
 - vi) new buildings should all have broadband provision as standard

Action

- It was also agreed that an additional chapter to the plan should be included headed Community Facilities, which would work to retain the Glebe and any other current community facility.

3.4 **Transport – Bob Pennyfather**

- AMD reported that various topics are being worked on within the group, including policies to support:
 - i) the impact of increased traffic on pedestrians and cyclists
 - ii) parking congestion
 - iii) how new development should maximize pedestrian access
 - iv) provision of parking within new homes
 - v) school footpaths
 - vi) bus service

3.5 **Housing – John Bettison**

- JB reported that he has arranged a meeting with Rachel Coates of AVBC to obtain any information they have on housing needs assessment for Crich Parish. Numbers here are important as it may be that the quotas have already now been met. Further details at the next meeting.
- ML has spoken to Julian Townsend at AVBC, but he offered no help in obtaining this information.
