IMPORTANT INFORMATION



For over two years, a group of Parish Councillors and other volunteers have, in consultation with the local community, worked to put together a Neighbourhood Plan covering Crich, Fritchley, Whatstandwell and surrounding areas.

A Neighbourhood Plan gives the local community the power to decide the type and location of any new development it wants, and importantly the type of development it does not want. Without a Neighbourhood Plan the Parish has ended up suffering unpopular large scale and intrusive developments on green field sites, such as Roes Lane Crich. The Plan also aims to protect and retain the green spaces between the villages and hamlets in the Parish.

The independent examination process for the Crich Parish Neighbourhood Plan (CPNP) has now been completed and the Plan has been given approval by Amber Valley Borough Council to go forward to a referendum of all the residents within the Parish.

The referendum is your opportunity to protect the nature of the Parish over the next 15 years.

It is probably one of the most important decisions that Parish residents will make and it will be your vote that counts.

If more than half of voters VOTE YES in the referendum being held on Thursday 19th July, the Neighbourhood Plan will be adopted for the area. From then on planning applications for new developments will have to comply with the Neighbourhood Plan.

Please use your vote on Thursday 19th July and VOTE YES to protect our beautiful area. On that day you can vote at the polling station that you go to at elections.
